The American Board of Anti-Aging Medicine (ABAAM) was established in 1997 as a professional physician (MD/DO/MBBS) certification. This is now known as American Board of Anti-Aging and Regenerative Medicine Certification (ABAARM). There are two parts: Written examinations – Diplomate (ABAARM) and Oral examination – Board Certified Physician (ABAARM). The written examination will be held in Malaysia. The oral examination can be taken only at the A4M meetings in U.S.

Part I. Written Examination

In ABAARM Part I, A three-hour multiple-choice written examination assesses proficiency in several areas of anti-aging clinical care, with a predominant focus on practical knowledge skills in diagnostic and therapeutic interventions, nutritional therapies, and pharmaceuticals, as well as sound textbook knowledge of endocrinology, neurophysiology, and cancer. After completion of all requirements for Part I and receipt of signed Diplomate certificate from the Board a physician may refer to him/herself as a "Diplomate" in anti-aging medicine.

Part II. Chart Review & Oral Examination

Presently, ABAARM Part II is only administered at the A4RM's "International Congress on Anti-Aging & Biomedical Technologies," held in the United States.

To maintain ABAARM certification, you must continue active membership in good standing in A4M.


